• ***Student Researchers of OHS: CTC/NYU Report***

Within the context of the Diversity Project at Ossining High School, fourteen Ossining High School students spent three weeks this summer conducting research about issues that face them and their fellow students in the Ossining community. With help from researchers at New York University (NYU), they are among the first young people in the area to investigate issues within their own school and community using “participatory research,” in which all concerned parties actively examine current situations together in order to change or improve them. The research was funded jointly by Ossining Communities That Care (CTC) and the District.

The students presented their findings to the Board of Education with a PowerPoint presentation. The group was joined by their advisors Emerly Martinez and Nancy Variano along with NYU Researcher Nicholas Handville.

The presentation was followed by comments from Board members who thanked the students for their efforts.
