## OHS Students Complete State Summer School of the Arts

(OSSINING, N.Y.) – Three Ossining High School students, Keith Greenbaum, Sophie Hall and Megan Wachs, completed study in the School of Visual Arts of the New York State Summer School of the Arts, held this summer at the State University of New York at Brockport.

Approximately 120 students with exceptional talent in the visual arts were selected for the month-long program through a rigorous screening process. Students spent approximately 100 to 125 hours in the studio, between 20 and 30 hours with visiting artists-in-residence and approximately 12 hours on gallery field trips. The students received certification that they satisfactorily completed study in the visual arts at least equal to a full unit of credit. The study may be used for the one-credit art and/or music Regents or local diploma requirement or part of a sequence.

The Ossining Union Free School District, nationally recognized for its mission to further the success of all children, serves approximately 4,200 pupils in six schools: Roosevelt School for newborn to four-year-olds, Park Early Childhood Center for kindergarten through first grade, Brookside School for grades two and three, Claremont School for grades four and five, Anne M. Dorner Middle School for grades six through eight, and Ossining High School for grades nine through 12.
