Ossining Middle Schoolers Chosen to Perform in NYSBDA Symposium

OSSINING, N.Y. — Three students from Anne M. Dorner Middle School have been chosen to play in the New York State Band Directors Association Symposium March 7-9 in Syracuse. The performers, Evan Olin, an 8th grade clarinetist; Jason Hickey, a 7th grade clarinetist; and Benjamin Kumka, a 7th grade trombonist, were chosen to play in the NYSBDA band based on their scores at NYSSMA (New York State School Music Association) and teacher recommendations. NYSBDA is part of the Council of Music Education Associations (COME), which is a coalition of music education and related organizations that work cooperatively with NYSSMA. AMD teachers and band directors Bradley Morrison and Tamara Caputo prepared and nominated the students for this honor.
