

Ossining Science Research Sets Another Record!

On Saturday, February 2nd, 2008, students in the Ossining Science Research Program rocked the 7th annual Westchester Rockland Junior Science and Humanities Symposium! In this fair, science research students compete from twenty-three local high schools in a formal, 12-minute PowerPoint presentation which is reviewed by a panel of judges for the quality of their research and the clarity of their presentation.

Six OHS students placed first in their category (Tyler Davidov, Micah Joselow, Robert Levine, Yingna Liu, Jessica Palmer, and Lee Saper), with a total of eleven students finishing in the top four. These students will continue on to the State level of the competition in Albany, NY in March competing for additional prizes and scholarships including a chance to continue to the National level of the competition where they will be eligible for up to \$16,000 in scholarship money and an all-expenses paid trip to London for the International Youth Science Forum.
