High School Mathematics Achievement: Report from Committee (Goal #3.1)

As a part of the Board of Education Goals for the school year a task force comprised of high school mathematics faculty has been examining mathematics course offerings available to high school students. The task force was charged to provide recommendations to support student achievement in mathematics and to determine if high school students should be required to take additional mathematics courses, beyond New York State's requirement, as a local graduation requirement. On Tuesday evening, May 22, 2007 Ms. Andra Meyerson, Director of Mathematics and Science, along with faculty members will provide the task force report to the Board.

In addition to the above, the Board will take action upon various recommendations of the administration regarding curriculum, business, and personnel matters.
